Salary of Mr S Noblett	£9,498	During the lockdown Mr Noblett produced a number of resources which were used to enhance our remote learning offer. The pupils were able to access high quality resources as part of a planned programme of lessons. Mr Noblett also planned and delivered sports days for each class in the school in the summer term.
Knowsley School Sports Partnership	£1,300	Our affiliation with the KPSSP provided us with resources to support our remote learning. We participated in a number of events which pupils completed at home as we encouraged them to be active. All our pupils competed in the virtual events during the Autumn Term and we were able to take part in one tournament before restrictions prevented us from going outside school.
Contribution to Teaching Assistant Salary	£4,473	During lock down Mr Spencer was responsible for providing opportunities for pupils to engage in sport during our face to face education sessions in school. These sports included: tennis, football, badminton and volleyball.
Enrich Education	£2,000	Our affiliation with Enrich Education continued to engage the pupils to involve themselves in enhancement opportunities including sports based activities.
Quidditch Day	£430	Our Quidditch Day provided the pupils with an opportunity to learn a new sport and increased participation in intra-school competitions as groups of pupils competed against each other.
